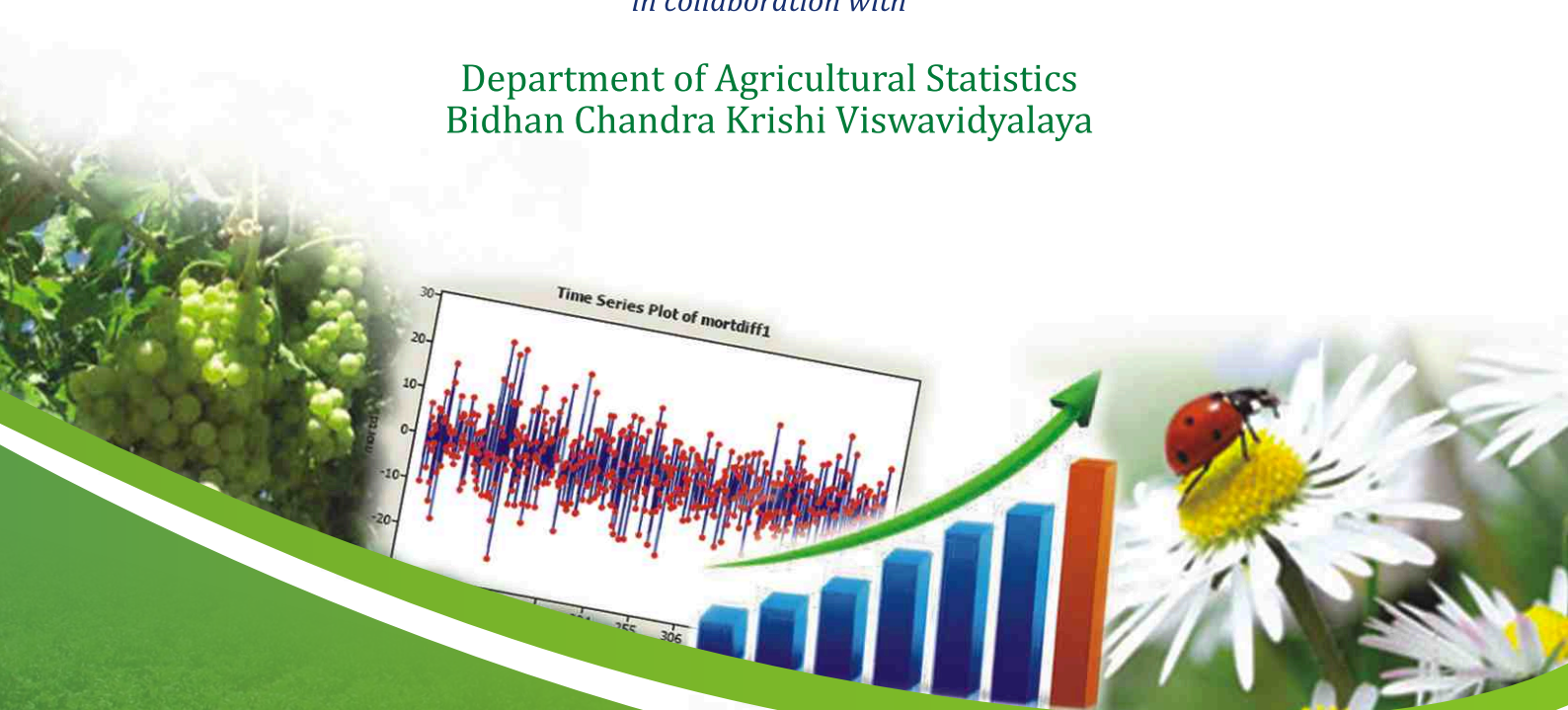

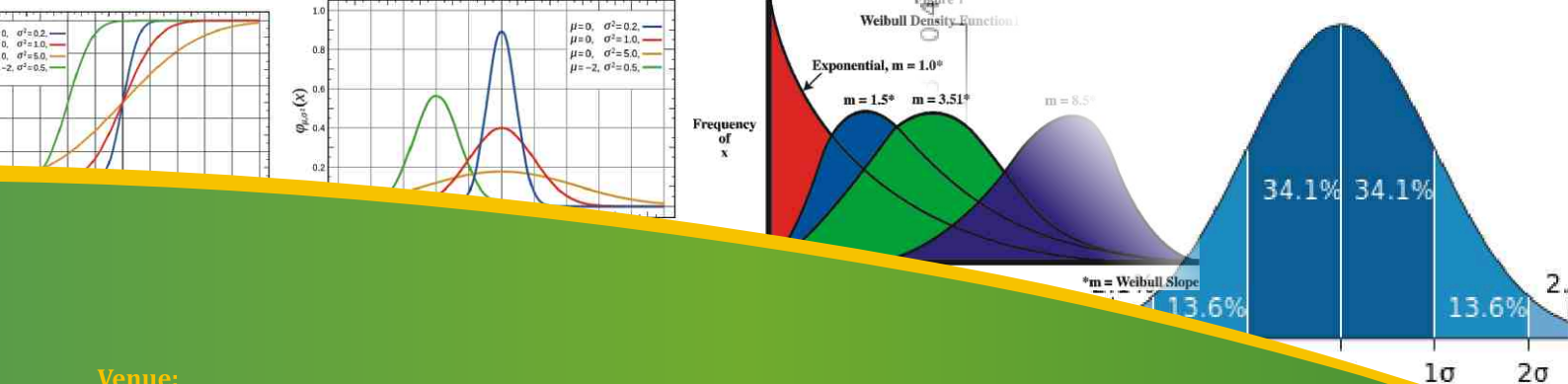
Invitation

Author should indicate the appropriate theme area for his or her submission. Best papers will be awarded in the seminar.
